



**SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT OF HOUSEHOLDS AND SMALL SCALE
INDUSTRIES IN LAOAG CITY**

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This study determined the solid waste management of households and small-scale industries of three (3) barangays in Laoag City classified as urban, peri-urban, and rural. It specifically determined the classification of wastes disposed of, the solid waste management practices, and the attitudes of residents on solid waste management.

The study employed the descriptive method of research with questionnaire as the main instrument in gathering the data and was supplemented by interviews.

Wastes that were commonly generated by the small-scale industries and households are papers, plastics, cans, metals, food wastes, and bottles. Majority of the respondents relied on the city garbage collector. However, some of the respondents employed composting, burning, and recycling.

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
